HOW TO GET THERE

Viva Sara Kaffée – Grote Markt 33 – 8500 Kortrijk - Belgium

Viva Sara Kaffée is accessible by means of any possible means of transport

BY CAR

The Viva Sara Kaffée is situated on the 'Grote Markt' (Grand Place) of Kortrijk and is right next to exit n° 2 of the E17 motorway:

- From Brussels: E40 motorway to Ghent - E17 motorway to Kortrijk - exit n° 2 Kortrijk Zuid / Expo (distance: 90 km)
- From Antwerp: E17 motorway to Kortrijk - exit n° 2 Kortrijk Zuid / Expo (distance: 98 km)
- From Mons-Tournai: E403 motorway - E17 motorway direction Ghent - exit n° 2 Kortrijk Zuid / Expo (distance: 30 km)
- From Ostend-Bruges: E403 motorway to Kortrijk - R8 direction Kortrijk Zuid - exit 't Hoge - exit n° 2 Kortrijk Zuid / Expo (distance from Ostend: 65 km - distance from Bruges: 50 km)
- From the Netherlands: A1 motorway to Breda - E17 motorway Antwerp-Ghent-Kortrijk - exit n° 2 Kortrijk Zuid / Expo (distance from Breda: 155 km)

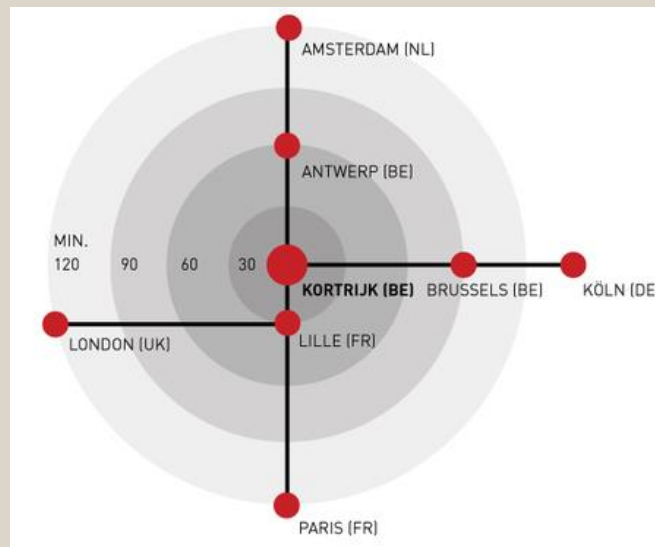

BY BUS & TRAIN

The train station of Kortrijk is at 450m of the Viva Sara Kaffée. Next to the train station is a big bus central. It only takes about 6 minutes to walk to the 'Grote Markt'.

BY PLANE

- From [Wevelgem](#): the International Schengen Airport Kortrijk-Wevelgem is known as a quick, flexible and easily accessible business airport. This small-scale airport complies with the needs of the customer in an extremely flexible and efficient way. The central location in Europe supports and strengthens the international character of the region. Kortrijk is located at 15 minutes from the airport.
- From [Zaventem](#): if you land at Brussels/Zaventem, go to the Brussels North train station and take the train to Kortrijk (distance: 100 km).
- From [Lille/Lesquin](#): if you land at Lille/Lesquin , take a taxi to the train station Lille Flandres and there take the train to Kortrijk (distance: 40 km).
